**Chenin Blanc** (sheh NEN BLONK) [Medium to Full Body]  
*South Africa's most widely planted grape variety produces medium to fuller bodied white wines, but generally maintains high levels of fresh, crisp, clean acidity. Aromas range from straw to honeyed characters, and is a good choice for strongly flavoured dishes. Occasionally produces quality dry whites when barrel-fermented.*

**Gewurztraminer** (ga VERTZ trah mee ner) [Medium to Full Body]  
*One of the most distinctively perfumed grapes in the world, Gewurz is the Alsace grape which smells of fragrant rose petals and Turkish Delight and tastes of lychees making it an extremely popular wine with newcomers. Widely grown in Europe (Italy, Germany and Eastern Europe) as well as in small quantities in Chile, South Africa, Oregon, California, Australia and New Zealand too.*

**Pinot Grigio/Gris** (PEE noh gree JOH / PEE noh GREE) [Medium to Full Body]  
*Pinot Gris is thought to be a mutation of Pinot Noir. It has greyish blue skin hence its name "Gris" which means Grey in French. In the classic region of Alsace, Pinot Gris is classified as a noble grape variety. The clone is grown in Italy and is known as Pinot Grigio. Good pairing with grilled seafood dishes such as fish, lobster, scallop and prawn.*

**Sauvignon Blanc** (saw win YAWN BLONK) [Light to Medium Body]  
Sauvignon Blanc originated in the Loire Valley of France. However, New Zealand has taken this grape to new heights in the cool Marlborough region, producing racy wines with tropical fruit and gooseberry flavours. It is usually a dry white wine with distinctive herbaceous qualities and is widely available as a single varietal or as a blend with Semillon. An ideal aperitif and matches well with sushi, sashimi, salad and seafood with light sauces.

**Semillon & Blend** (seh MEE YAWN) [Medium to Full Body]  
Semillon is a gold-skinned grape generally known for its richness and body and is often used to complement the aromatic Sauvignon Blanc and revered sweet wines, notably Sauternes. It is responsible for some of Australia's most individual dry whites, in particular those from the Hunter Valley, which develop a buttered toast character with age. The Barossa Valley Semillons can also be excellent.

**Cabernet Franc** (KA-behr-nay FRAHN) [Medium Body]  
 If Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot are, respectively Bordeaux's king and queen, Cabernet Franc is its prince. Found predominately in the Loire Valley and Bordeaux, it is the sixth most widely planted red grape variety in France and tends to be more herbaceous in style and often described as having the aroma of pencil shavings, herbal and peppery, with notes of tobacco leaf, menthol, and liquorice, and often rather dry-edged tannins.

**Carmenere** (kar mer nee YEH) [Medium to Full Body]

Chile's own signature grape, this varietal disappeared from European vineyards in the mid-19th century and reappeared among Chile's Merlot vines a hundred years later. The deepest, darkest, purplest of all red grapes need a long growing season to reach its fullest potential. Rich in berry fruits and spice with smooth, well-rounded tannins make this a very pleasing and easy to drink varietal.

**Corvina** (kor WEE nah)

[Medium Body]

Along with the rarities of Molinara and Rondinella found mainly in North East of Italy, they form the classic wines of Valpolicella. A light to medium bodied wine in general, but still with a great chewy and distinct cherry flavour.

[Medium Body]

Dolcetto is an indigenous varietal to Piedmont, Italy and the name means "little sweet one" in Italian. Its low acidity and tannins make it perfect for lapping up risotto and pasta. Made for drinking young, it's alive with vibrant plummy, liquorice-like fruitiness, although some Piemontese producers make a more serious, richer style too.

[Medium Body]

Barbera is the most widely planted grape in Piedmont, north west of Italy. It is growing in reputation and capable of producing some very exciting and delicious wines. **Grenache** (gren AASH / gah nah CHAH)

[Full Body]

This is quintessentially a Mediterranean red variety and the primary component in nearly all of Southern Rhône's red blends. Grenache is the base varietal for renowned wines from Châteauneuf du Pape and Cotes du Rhône. In Spain it is known as Garnacha Tinta or Granaxta Negra where it's widely planted, particularly in Rioja and Priorat.

**Malbec** (marl BECK)

[Medium to Full Body]

Malbec, a black grape which is responsible for making the Black wine of Cahor in south-west of France. It is also known as Côt. While it can produce wines that taste rather rustically gamey, however in the best of Cahor in France and Mendoza in Argentina, the wines can be deeply coloured, juicy, with raspberry, mulberry and game-like undertones.

Although it is the most planted red grape varietal in Bordeaux, it has been considered the junior partner in the great Cabernet Sauvignons. Merlot has achieved growing popularity in the last decade to the extent of cult worship of certain Merlot based wines from Saint Emilion and Pomerol in Bordeaux, Italy, California and Chile.

**Nebbiolo** (neh BE O lo)

[Full Body]

Arguably Italy's greatest red grape variety of Piedmont for the great reds of Barolo and Barbaresco. This tricky grape variety is difficult to grow but produces a range of fabulous violet and rose-like perfumes, flavoured with truffle, fennel and liquorice which makes it one of the world's most distinctive grape varieties. Named for the Italian nebbia, meaning fog, in consideration of the mists which enshroud the limestone hills of Monforte around Alba.

[Medium Body]

This is South Africa's signature variety which was bred in 1925 as a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut. Pinotage is often deep red with earthy flavours resplendent of fruits, with hints of chocolate, cherry and some savoury elements which help to create a very elegant wine matching with red meats or strong blue cheese.

**Sangiovese** (sun ge o WAY say)

[Medium to Full Body]

Sangiovese meaning "blood of Jupiter" is the main Chianti grape which produces a variety of styles from youthfully lively young reds to the richer, more concentrated, long-lived and oak-aged style. Brunello comes from the name locals in Montalcino historically gave to the Sangiovese grape, due to the deep garnet colour of the wine. "Bruno" means "dark reddish-brown".
