06' Diebolt-Vallois Blanc de Blancs Crémant, France

Established in Crémant in the "Cote des Blancs" where the best Chardonnay come from, the winery produce a beautifully crafted elegant Champagne displaying great concentration with multiple layers of flavour through to the long, buttery finish.

Hatt et Söner Grande Cuvée Rosé, NV Bergères-le-Vin, France

HATT et SÖNER is a champagne house with the ambition of producing champagne of the highest conceivable quality using only grapes exclusively from Premier Cru and Grand Cru. Brilliant raspberry colour with orange highlights, the bubbles are smooth and persistent. The palate strikes a balance between fresh and steadfast flavours.

Marguerite Guyot Cuvée Fleur de Flo Rosé, NV Dommery, France

"Seduction" - An original range of Dommery, characterized by a refined and elegant personality, reflected in a creative design, inspired by the harmony of the nature, and the woman's sensuality. The light cherry pink coloured champagne has dried strawberries and roses on the nose. Has a good touch of fruits but is simple and straightforward, full an almost jumpy final quality on the short finish.

Using geothermy methods and a stringent sustainable development approach the cuvée is a true gem with a wide variety of flavours in which the perfect blend of power and finesse bestows a full flavour. Production is limited to 5000 bottles only.

Gosset Grande Réserve brut, NV (1000ml) Ay, France

490

Gosset produced wine with style, made fit for a place at the table of the Kings of France back in the 15th. Preserving the heritage of the antique flask, used in the 18th century when Gosset started making Champagne and add the same way today. A rich expression of ripe and dried fruit, a gentle persistent freshness comes through.

00' Pol Roger Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill Epernay, France

Created to commemorate the long lasting friendship between Pol Roger and Sir Winston Churchill dating back to the liberation of Paris, the Prestige Cuvée is a reflection and a homage to that era: robustness, a full-bodied character and relative maturity.

Champagne of the Millenium! The cuvée Nicolas François Billecart 20th was chosen by a committee of experts at a blind tasting session involving 150 winemakers from the most illustrious champagne producers. Its vinification, partially in traditional oak casks, underpins the generous character of this fine, elegant and rich wine.

Krug Rosé, NV Reims, France

Krug Rosé is the only prestige cuvée rose to be blended from a rich palette of 120 wines from three different grape varieties. These are blended with a wonderfully expressive de-feminized Pinot Noir wine to deliver its unparalleled and characteristic colour and opulence. Krug Rosé is described as a gastronomic Champagne for its unmatched finesse and character.



93 Dural Leroy Brut Cuvée Femme de Champagne, 2000

DURAL LEROY is one of the few remaining 100% family-owned Champagne houses and is ranked in the 15 top Champagne houses. Its yellow gold color comes from the strands of bubbles, which reveal complex notes of a lively melody. After the first initial burst of flavor in the mouth comes a silky touch interwoven with remarkable length on the palate.
