- Hi Thai Tea** 280
Don't even think about raising your little pinky while sipping on this.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Tea blend. Tahitian limes.
- Rose Lemonade** 280
Cutting right through the humidity, a rose garden complete with light, refreshing lemonade.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Rose water. Fresh lemons n sugar.
- Earl's Court Sling** 320
Notes of freshly cut cricket lawns combined with French herbs n spices give strength to this colonially inspired long drink.
Tanqueray gin. Green Chartreuse. Tonic. Lime n zest.
- Kiku Vesper** 340
Japanese for "Chrysanthemum," the "Kiku" Vesper is KU DÉ TA's forage into the literary world of Ian Fleming. James Bond first ordered his "Vesper Martini" in the 1953 novel *Casino Royale*.
Tanqueray gin. Yuzu shochu. Homemade dry sake tonic.
- Asian Boulevardier** 360
The boulevardier is the cousin of the Negroni. Here we slip out the gin and slip in the bourbon. The name itself, "Boulevardier" comes from a monthly magazine, a sort of Parisian *New Yorker*, in the early-mid 1920s.
Wild Turkey bourbon. Campari. Handmade, Asian spiced tonic.
- Godzilla Gimlet** 320
Godzilla is a "kaiju" or Japanese giant monster, that has appeared in 28 film productions, numerous video games, novels, TV series, and now a cocktail.
Tanqueray gin. Shiso lime cordial. Celery bitters.

Black Pearl	280
The spirit gods smile upon this Asian-Caribbean flavor bomb of home baked rums. Handcrafted rum concoction. Long pepper infused pineapple syrup. Fist bump.	
Havana 86	280
An award-winning cocktail from the Nordic Bar Syndicate team straight outta Copenhagen. Pampero rum. Tahitian lime juice. Loads of chocolate.	
Storm Cooler	320
A passionate balance of sweet, sour, and spice. A tropical jacket of good times. Stoli Red Label vodka. Passion fruit n honey. Lakrids raw licorice powder.	
Papaya-Honey Flip	360
The "flip" is a class of mixed drinks first used in 1695 to describe a mixture of beer, rum, sugar and heat. Papaya beer. Light rum. Calvados n honeyed egg whites.	
Hurricane Lychee	360
The Ramos fizz is the most feared and loved cocktail of a professional bartender's repertoire. It's loved for its history, but feared for what it does to their arms (shaken for 12-15 minutes). This cocktail represents a benchmark for any serious cocktail bar and its staff. Our Thai take on the classic. Tanqueray gin. Lychees. Fizzy egg whites, cream, sugar n soda.	
Osaka Noodle Market	360
Heavy production of the shiso leaf did not begin in earnest until around 1960; coming into favor at an Osakajin fresh market. Tanqueray gin. Shiso leaves. Cucumber, honey n limes.	

VINTAGE

- Moscow Mule** 280
Vodka? What's vodka? Prior to the creation of this cocktail in Los Angles in 1941, very few people in America knew.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Ginger ale. Zesty lime.
- Aperol Spritz** 320
Also known as the "Venetian Spritz" or "Italian Spritz"- a traditional Venetian aperitif created in 1919, but did not become a hit until shortly after WWII.
Slight bitter-sweet Aperol. White wine. Soda. Floral essence.
- Tatanka** 360
The national cocktail of Poland, "Tatanka" means "American bison" in the Lakota language, while the Polish name for the only bison that reside in Poland is "zubr," which helps give name to the vodka used.
Zubrowka Bison Grass vodka. Freshly pressed Granny Smith apple juice.
Wide open fields.
- Bijou** 360
Meaning "jewel" in French, combines the colors of 3 jewels: gin for diamond, vermouth for ruby, and Green Chartreuse for emerald. Dates back to 1900.
Tanqueray gin. Green chartreuse. Martini Rosso.
- Rusty Nail** 360
We first see the name of this cocktail at the "21 Club" in New York, in roughly 1931. "21," a former prohibition speakeasy, held the private wine collection for celebs such as Marilyn Monroe, John F. Kennedy, and Richard Nixon.
Johnny Walker Black scotch. Drambuie. Stirred with confidence.
- Prince of Wales** 420
Composed by Albert Edward, Prince of Wales, later to be King Edward VII.
Cognac. Sugar n bitters. Happy bubbles.

VINTAGE

- Daiquiri** 280
The name Daiquiri is also the name of a beach near Santiago, Cuba and an iron mine in the same area. Supposedly created by an American mining engineer living in Cuba at the time of the Spanish-American war. (1898)
Handcrafted, secret recipe grog. Fresh lime juice. Cane sugar syrup.
- Queen's Park Swizzle** 280
Established well before the Mojito, try to drink this slowly, if possible.
Rums. Mint n lime. Bitters. And yeah, ginger ale.
- Albemarle Fizz** 320
From Sir Walter Raleigh's "Lost Colony" to existing homes that stood decades before the Revolutionary War, Albemarle, North Carolina is a land of rich drinking traditions.
Tanqueray gin. Barrels of raspberries. Natural spring water.
- Bramble** 320
It's been called the Riesling of the cocktail world - well known to most drink aficionados (since the 80's), but unknown to most drinkers.
Tanqueray gin. Fresh lemon juice. Crème de Mure.
- The Last Word** 380
A gin based prohibition-era cocktail originally developed at the Detroit Athletic Club.
Tanqueray gin. Maraschino liquor. Green Chartreuse. Fresh lime juice.
- Singapore Sling** 380
Perhaps you know the story already. Developed sometime before 1915 at the Long Bar in the Raffles Hotel, Singapore, the recipe presented here is true to the original.
Tanqueray gin. Cherry Heering. Fresh pineapples, lemon, grenadine n bitters.
