Hi Thai Tea 280

Don't even think about raising your little pinky while sipping on this.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Tea blend. Tahitian limes.

Not a Rum & Coke 280

The drink Tom Cruise should have made when asked for a Cuba Libre in the movie "Cocktail." (1988).
Pampero rum. Kahlua. Ginger ale n limes.

Draper's Apples 320

"Let's take it a little slower. I don't want to wake up pregnant." Season 1, Smoke Gets in Your Eyes – *Mad Men* – Don Draper.
Bespoke rum grog. Artisanal apple syrup. Orange bitters.

Earl's Court Sling 320

Notes of freshly cut cricket lawns combined with French herbs n spices give strength to this colonially inspired long drink.
Tanqueray gin. Green Chartreuse. Tonic. Lime n zest.

Kiku Vesper 340

Japanese for "Chrysanthemum," the "Kiku" Vesper is Ku Dé Ta's forage into the literary world of Ian Fleming. James Bond first ordered his "Vesper Martini" in the 1953 novel *Casino Royale*.
Tanqueray gin. Yuzu shochu. Homemade dry sake tonic.

Manhattan Downtown 360

The Manhattan is subject to considerable variation and innovation, and is often a way for the best bartenders to show off their creativity. Here we let loose a little bit.
Wild Turkey bourbon. Galliano L'Autentico. Martini Rosso n bitters.

HANDCRAFTED

- Mexican Love Swizzle** 280
Fresh, roasted pineapples synergize with the round body of the agavian, tequila love spirit.
Chili infused El Jimador tequila. Pineapples. Give it a swizzle.
- Black Pearl** 280
The spirit gods smile upon this Asian-Caribbean flavor bomb of home baked rums.
Handcrafted rum concoction. Long pepper infused pineapple syrup. Fist bump.
- Thai Basil Smash** 320
Like the Cobbler, the Sling, the Cocktail and the Toddy, the Smash is another style of old drink intended to be imbibed quickly and easily.
Tanqueray gin. Sake. Thai basil smashed with lemons n sugar.
- Storm Cooler** 320
A passionate balance of sweet, sour, and spice. A tropical jacket of good times.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Passion fruit n honey. Lakrids raw licorice powder.
- Ringo's Tinkle** 340
Upon discovering that the word for "apple" in Japanese is "ringo," we simply could not pass up this cocktail naming opportunity.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Apple liqueur. Lime, sugar, ginger n mint.
- Berryman Cobbler** 360
A "cobbler" is an old form of a mixed drink that consists of a base spirit, sugar, and fresh fruit. It dates to at least the 1830s, and was one of the first drinks to use ice and straws; items completely foreign at the time.
Tanqueray gin. Crème de Mure. High class blackberries.

VINTAGE

- Woo Woo** 280
No classic cocktail list would be complete without at least a nod to TGIF's.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Peach schnapps. Cranberry juice. Lime.
- Queen's Park Swizzle** 280
Established well before the Mojito, try to drink this slowly, if possible.
Rums. Mint n lime. Bitters. And yeah, ginger ale.
- Harvey Wallbanger** 320
Brought to international prominence in 1952 by a Galliano salesman, the Harvey Wallbanger takes it's name from a Manhattan Beach surfer living in Hollywood at the same time.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Freshly squeezed orange juice. Laced with vanilla.
- Dark 'n Stormy** 320
Brought home by various sailors that visited the Bermuda islands, this cocktail is now considered the national drink of Bermuda.
Gosling's Black Seal rum. Ginger beer. Lime.
- Corn 'n Oil** 320
Although the origins of this drink are murky, it's experiencing a massive resurgence in the cocktail world, especially in the Caribbean.
Ku Dé Ta's special, hand-crafted grog. Lime. Falernum.
- Vodka Martini** 360
Fierce competition exists about the origins of this drink. Regardless, the ease of obtaining illegal spirits during prohibition led to the rise of this predominant cocktail of the mid 20th century.
Belvedere vodka stirred. Dry vermouth. You choose: twist or olives.

VINTAGE

- Bramble** 300
It's been called the Riesling of the cocktail world - well known to most drink aficionados (since the 80's), but unknown to most drinkers.
Tanqueray gin. Fresh lemon juice. Crème de Mure.
- White Russian** 320
Neither the Black or White Russians are Russian in origin, but both are so named due to vodka being the primary ingredient. First appeared in 1949.
Stoli Red Label vodka. Coffee liqueur. Cream.
- Tequila Negroni** 320
Founded by Count Camillo Negroni in Florence, Italy in 1919, the best quote attributed to this drink, from Orson Welles, "The bitters are excellent for your liver, the gin is bad for you. They balance each other."
El Jimador blanco. Aperol. Martini Rosso.
- Old Fashioned** 320
History is repeated when cocktails classified as "old-fashioned" become the "new-fashioned."
Wild Turkey bourbon. Sugar n bitters. Fiery zest.
- Whiskey Sour** 340
The first mention of the Whiskey Sour appeared in a newspaper from Wisconsin in 1870. A true sign of a bartender's craftsmanship is to create this classic bourbon sour with the perfect balance.
Wild Turkey. Lemon juice. Tasty, frothy stuff.
- Zombie (max 2 servings per person)** 380
Originally created to assist recovery for hangovers, imbibers quickly complained of being turned into mindless zombies. The Walking Dead as early as the 1930s.
Multiple rums. Passion fruit. Bitters. No Blood.

FAST AND FURIOUS SHOOTERS

Yuzu Drop 280

The yuzu is believed to be a hybrid of sour mandarin and Ichang papeda. What the heck is Ichang papeda? Don't know, but this shooter is a lemon drop on roids.

Stoli Red Label vodka. Yuzu shochu. Sugar sweetie.

The Monastic 320

A quick one dedicated to religious pursuits and spiritual crusades.

Enlightened Frangelico. Baileys Irish Cream. Meditative Green Chartreuse.

French Fairy 320

You've heard what happens when you drink the Green Fairy (Absinthe), haven't you? All true.

Absinthe. White chocolate. Puckery lemon.

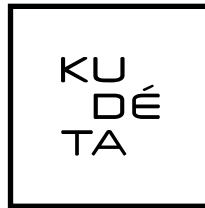
